ARTICLE IX "SIGNS"

SECTION 400.1870 TEMPORARY SIGNS

Temporary signs may be allowed as follows:

- A. There shall be no restriction on the number and size of temporary non-commercial signs in all districts.
- B. Temporary commercial signs shall be allowed only upon issuance of a sign permit in conformance with this Article, which shall specify the size and location of the temporary sign as well as the time period for which it may be displayed.
- C. **Temporary commercial signs:**
 - 1. Shall be displayed for no more than 120 total days per lot, in any calendar year;
 - 2. Shall not exceed sixty (60) square feet in area;
 - 3. Shall not exceed one (1) sign per street frontage;
 - 4. Shall not be displayed prior to forty-five (45) days before nor after ten (10) days following an event being advertised; and
 - 5. MUST be displayed "on-premises."
- D. **Commercial banner signs may be allowed as follows:**
 - 1. Seven (7) days or less, no size limitation;
 - 2. More than seven (7) days, all banner signs shall be limited to sixty (60) square feet or obtain approval from the Board of Aldermen to allow greater than sixty (60) square feet of signage.
 - 3. Shall be displayed for no more than one hundred twenty (120) days per lot in a calendar year.
 - 4. Shall not exceed one (1) sign per street frontage.
 - 5. Shall not be displayed prior to forty-five (45) days before nor after three (3) days following an event being advertised.
 - 6. Displayed "On-premises"
 - 7. The Board of Aldermen may approve "Off-premise" banner signs.

SECTION 400.1810 PROHIBITED SIGNS

The following signs are prohibited in all Districts and shall be removed in accordance with SECTION 400.1940: SIGN REMOVAL

- A. Outdoor advertising (poster panels, billboards and off-site promotional signs), except where a special use permit has been obtained for such sign;
- B. Snipe signs;
- C. Directly illuminated signs, except to the extent specifically authorized in this Article;
- D. Pole signs;
- E. Roof signs;
- F. Signs in the public right-of-way;
- G. Obsolete signs;
- H. Abandoned non-conforming signs;
- I. Flashing, blinking, moving, or otherwise animated signs;
- J. Signs containing obscene messages; and
- K. Signs containing false or misleading advertising.
