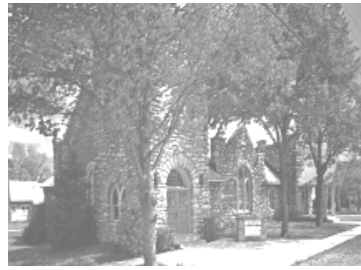


FUND4BOOKS

FALL TRASH DAYS SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 21 AND 22, 2011

The annual "Fall Trash Days" event provides a way for Peculiar residents to get rid of bulky trash items and/or yard waste that can't be placed at the curb with your regular weekly trash. The drop-off times are as follows:

Friday, October 21 from 7:00AM to 6:00PM
Saturday, October 22 from 8:00AM to 4:00PM

The drop-off site is located at the City "Salt Shed" which is located at the south end of the East Outer Road of U.S. 71 Highway (just north of the sewage treatment plant). If you have questions or need directions to the site, please call City Hall at 816-779-5212.

Hazardous material such as paint, motor oil, fuels, antifreeze, household cleaners, pesticides, pool chemicals and batteries cannot be accepted at the event. However, please refer to the **Household Hazardous Waste** article in this newsletter for information on a separate City program for disposal of these items.



Proof of residency within the city limits is required for the Trash Days event and must be presented at the gate (valid driver's license or recent water bill). There will be a small fee per vehicle and for some larger items. For more information, contact City Hall at 816-779-5212.

THE MAYOR'S MESSAGE

First, a few words about our efforts to improve the infrastructure of Peculiar. Recently a number of streets on the west side of 71 Highway were resurfaced. Next year we plan to resurface some streets on the east side. On October 4 we received bids on the proposed sanitary sewer improvements. You should see some of this work begin before the first of the year. This sanitary sewer work is being financed by the \$12 bond charge that appears on your monthly utility bill. The City of Peculiar plans to improve its infrastructure each and every year.

I receive many complaints about the condition of the bridge over 71 Highway. This bridge is owned by MoDOT and is their responsibility to maintain. We bring your concerns to their attention. Soon the City of Peculiar will be meeting with MoDOT about their future plans to repair this bridge. I will keep you updated about this.

Please contact me with any questions and I will try to answer them. If you have any problems with the City, I will help solve them. The goal of the City of Peculiar is to improve our City till it is the best small city in Missouri.

I hope to see you at the Harvest Moon Festival on October 29th.

YARD WASTE CLEAN UP EVENT

Town and Country offers bulk item pick up once a month. You may choose any one Friday of the month to place one bulk item at the curb for pick up at no extra cost. Appliances are not considered bulk items and will not be picked up so please do not set any appliances at the curb.

Town and Country will pick up yard waste twice per year at no additional cost. This fall they are scheduled for yard waste pick up on Sat., November 5th . Yard waste will be accepted in bundles 24" in diameter and no longer than 4' lengths. Clippings and leaves must be placed in paper bags and a maximum of 25 bags per household will be picked up. Please have your yard waste at the curb by 7:00 a.m. to guarantee pick up.
